Latin Help for Parents

Latin is the mother tongue of Western civilization as the Romans handed down the original thinking of the ancient world to us in this language. Latin provides the root words for the modern sciences, and it is the language of law, government, logic, and theology.

Although Heritage students begin studying Latin in Class 3, many Heritage parents did not benefit from an education that included instruction in Latin. This workshop will help parents learn enough basic information about Latin that you will feel comfortable helping your children study vocabulary and charts, discuss homework or concepts studied in the classroom, and listen while your student explains grammar. This workshop is designed for parents of students C₃-C₉ who want to be better equipped in how to help their children with the study of Latin.
